

Dino Chutes, Inc. Parachute Protector

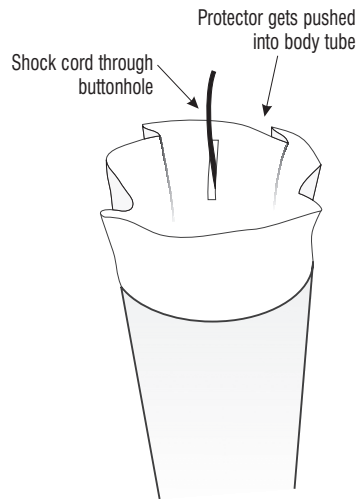
Thank you for your purchase of this premium parachute protector. This product is constructed from a flame-retardant fabric designed to reduce the chances of your parachute getting damaged. This product is offered as a lower cost alternative to 100% Nomex fabric protectors that generally last longer. As with any rocketry product, you will have to determine the suitability of this product for your use.

The reinforced buttonhole in the protector can be cut open to the size needed for your shock cord to be routed through the fabric.

Some users simply insert the parachute into the cupped protector while others pre-wrap the parachute in the protector in more of a burrito type roll.

For additional protection, you can also use an amount of cellulose insulation in your airframe below the protector. This sort of insulation material is commonly sold at big-box hardware stores as blown-in insulation. This will substantially increase the life of your protector and other recovery gear and is highly recommended.

Depending of how tightly you push your parachute into the protector, the protector may or may not get ejected out of your body tube. Either situation is just fine, but be sure to check the inside of your body tube after use to make sure that there is no damage from excess heat buildup if the protector stays inside of the body tube.



Always inspect your rocket and protector before and after each flight to ensure that your rocket and protector are in a suitable condition for flying.

Washing instructions: all detergents sold for home use can be used, except products containing chlorine bleach, peroxide bleach and enzymes. The protector should be adequately rinsed to prevent mineral and detergent build up in the fabric. Natural soaps that are labeled as “soaps” should not be used. Starch, fabric softener and other laundry additives are not recommended.
